## **REPORT ON FEEDBACK ANALYSIS -2018-19**

Feedback is an essential element of the learning process. The campus collects the feedback on various curriculum aspects and courses from different stakeholders such as the students, alumni, Faculty and Parents using structured proforma through ofline. The feedback collected from the individuals has been analyzed and taken to the consideration for the development of curriculum, teaching learning process and environment.

### **Feedback from Students:**


The campus has a structured proforma for obtaining feedback from the primary stakeholder i.e. students. The Students' Feedback on curriculum and teaching learning process at K.J.Somaiya premise is designed to get formative feedback from students that can be used towards the improvements in the quality of course design and delivery, as well as student learning experiences. For the academic year 2018-2019, students' feedback is sought from around 30 students about the curriculum and teaching learning process. Majority of the student population agreed that the syllabus is adequate and the allocation of credits is appropriate in relation to the level of course work. Majority of the students (90%) agreed teachers complete the entire syllabus in time and teachers discuss and interact the topics (84%). It is observed that 80% of the respondents agreed that 91.3% of them agreed that office staff are very much cooperative and helpful and 93.4% agreed that library facilities are adequate. Also, majority of students (73.3%) agreed that the laboratory experiences and practical exposure given to them enhanced their understanding of the concepts and enable them to relate theoretical components to practice.

 $\succ$  The analysis of the students' feedback clearly depicts that they are well satisfied with the curriculum development, revision and evaluation and teachers punctuality.

 $\succ$  The students highly appreciated the academic related infrastructural facilities such as library, laboratories, playground and other facilities.


> It is observed from the students' feedback that few of them expressed the need of more ICT facilities.




**Questionnaires for Feedback from Students** 






**Student Feedback on Teachers** 



#### Feedback from Parents:

Feedback obtained from the parents is considered as vital for the development of any educational institution. Parents' feedback is taken from approximately 30 parents about the curriculum and the institution for the year 2018-2019. Majority of 57% of the parents expressed that the infrastructure of the college is very good. Academic discipline in terms of timely conduct of lectures, practical and other activities is highly appreciated by them. Majority of the parents felt that quality of the teaching and training provided at the institution and its contribution to their wards overall personality development as excellent and also academic skill & knowledge of the faculty members is excellent (45%). 63% parents are satisfied that the extra curricular activity of campus. It was rated as excellent by majority of the parents regarding the availability and sharing of relevant information on the University website. Majority of 55% of the parents reported that the Teacher student relations are excellent. About 45% of them appreciated overall performance of the University.
